- Sunday 3rd April
 - Racing starts from 8:30am (2 QLF rounds)

Award and Prizes:

- Trophies will be awarded to all A finalist.
- TQ will also be awarded a separate trophy.
- Prize for each 1st place for GP classes will be GREE Air Conditioning Split System.

General rules for EP:

- 2 or 4 door sedan no sports/GT/GTP types bodies for stock and modified class.
- Any Ni-MH battery (7.2v) and any hard case Li-PO battery (7.4v) may be used.
- Tires (rubber or foam) are open for all classes.
- All cars must have independent suspension and must not use direct drive transmission (except 12th scale class).
- Only one rear wing is allowed. No front wings permitted.
- A minimum of six entries per class is required, for said class to run.

QLFs

- The heat for TC Modified will be 5 minutes with maximum of 10 cars per heat.
- The heat for TC Stock will be 6 minutes with maximum of 10 cars per heat.
- The heat for 12th scale class will be 8 minutes with maximum of 10 cars per heat.

FINALS

- The final for TC Modified will be 5 minutes with maximum of 10 cars and minimum of 4 cars per final.
- The final for TC Stock will be 6 minutes with maximum of 10 cars and minimum of 4 cars per final.
- The final for 12th scale class will be 8 minutes with maximum of 10 cars and minimum of 4 cars per final.
- The A main will have 3 finals and one final each for lower finals

Modified:

- The use of any brushed or brushless motors is allowed.

Stock:

- The motors for this class will be 17.5T brushless or 23T brushed motors.

1:12th

- All cars must be two wheel drive & use direct drive transmission
- The use of any brushed or brushless motors is allowed.

General rules for GP:

- Any sedan bodies with EFRA approval no sports/GT/GTP types bodies.
- All finals will be the ABC system. A-30 minutes, B-20 minutes, C-10 minutes and all lower final will be 5 minutes.
- The top three from the lower finals will bump up to the next final.
- All heats for GP will be 5 minutes each with 8 cars in the heats and minimum of 4 cars in the finals.

Driver Responsibilities:

- 1) You must Marshall the race immediately after your race is finished, failure to do so will result in losing your best qualifying time in that class.
- 2) No repairs are to be carried out by marshalls nor are those marshalls to return a stopped car to the pit area – such work should be done by the pit crew.
- 3) Drivers are responsible for securely mounting the transponders and returning them after each race finishes – if a transponder falls out of a car, that car will not be manual counted.
- 4) Immediately after the race is over, place the car in the scrutineering pound and transponders in the rack. Drivers should then move straight to their marshalling station.
- 5) Cars will be subject to random scrutineering through the day. The first three placegetters in the A Final will be scrutineered immediately after conclusion of the race (s). Cars failing scrutineering or failing to be presented for scrutineering may lose the result of the previous race.
