## Information

#### **Qualifying**

- 5 Qualifiers will be run per class.
- Points will be awarded for your overall finishing position in each qualifier (time/distance).
- Best 3 results out of 5 will be added together to produce your Qualifying Position.
- IFMAR staggered start.
- 6 minute qualifiers for all classes except Open which will be 5 minutes.
- Starting position for Qualifier 1 will be determined by the organizers. Starting position for Qualifiers 2 5 will be determined by your finishing position in the previous qualifier.
- No re-grading will occur during qualifying but a qualifying report will be printed at the end of each qualifying round so you can see how you are tracking against those in your class.

#### **Finals**

- Grid start.
- Grid positions determined by Qualifying.
- All finals (A, B, C etc) will have 5 races per class.
- Best 3 results will be counted with worst 2 results dropped.

#### **Tyres**

### \* Mini & Touring 540 Pro

Tyres are open. No limit on the number of sets of tyres used.

#### \* Touring Cars 21.5, 13.5 & Open

The following control tyre, insert and rim will be used and must be purchased at time of entry:

- Sorex 36, Sorex yellow insert, Schumacher Revlite nylon rim, pre-assembled and glued.

There will be a maximum of two sets allowed for these classes. This tyre must be purchased from the race organizers at a special reduced price of \$35 per set. Either of the two sets may be used at any time during Qualifying or Finals. One optional set of tyres can be pre-ordered for the practice day (Nov 25, Friday) at \$35 on the Entry Form. Alternately tyres can be purchased from Metro Hobbies at retail price (www.metrohobby.com.au).

Tyres are pre-assembled and glued at the factory. There are to be no modifications made to the tyre assembly (i.e. air holes in the rims must not be made bigger). Re-gluing and tyre balancing is allowed.

Tyres will be marked by race organizers. It is the drivers' responsibility to ensure that all identifying marks on the tyre assembly are not damaged. If they are damaged the tyre assembly may not be used.

Tyres must be collected prior to racing and must be returned before you leave the track for the day on Saturday.

#### **Trophies**

TQ, 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each class will receive a trophy. There will also be a Concourse Trophy and prize for best painted body shell sponsored by Andrews Scale Models (www.andrewsscalemodels.com.au) and the President's trophy for good sportsmanship.

#### **Transponders**

Personal transponders are welcome. Club transponders will be available.

#### **Catering**

Rotary Club Canteen & barrista coffee will be available on site.

#### **Track Layout**

Track layout will be Track 2. A diagram is available on the TFTR website: www.tftr.org.au -> About Us -> Track Layout. The current club day layout is Track 4 Reversed and therefore the local track advantage is minimised as much as practical.

#### **Technical Regulations**

VORTEC rules will apply as stated on the VORTEC website http://vortec.defmondo.com For convenience certain rules are repeated below:

#### \* Lipo Batteries

- Any 2 cell hard-cased approved 7.4V Lipo packs as listed on the ROAR website http://www.roarracing.com/approvals/lipobattery.php
- Lipo batteries must be charged in a Lipo sack.

#### \* Min

- Minimum weight 1330 g with transponder

#### \* Touring Car

- Minimum weight 1350 g with transponder
- Body width 190 mm without body shell, 195 mm with body shell
- Body Shell 4 door sedan body shells only in all Touring Car classes except 540 Pro which has unrestricted body shells
- Minimum height 115 mm with body shell
- Wings 40 mm x 20 mm measured horizontally and vertically (not diagonally)
- Electronic Speed Controls open / unrestricted

#### \* Additional rules

- 540 Pro use Silver Can motors only, as specified in the VORTEC rules.
- Top of wing must not be higher than the roof line of a Touring Car.
- Cooling holes in body shell are not allowed.
- In the interests of safety the event organisers recommend that all 240V electrical equipment be tested for safety prior to the event (eg; power supplies, soldering irons, power boards). We reserve the right to refuse the use of any equipment considered unsafe.
- Club air compressor is available for use by all racers. Personal air compressor may not be used to reduce noise and potential power spikes.
- You may not enter more than one Touring Car class i.e. only one entry per Racer in 540 Pro, 21.5, 13.5 or Open.
