Format

1. Two electric (EP) and two nitro (GP) classes will be raced: EP Stock and Modified Touring Cars and GP Open and Pull Start Touring Cars. An entrant can enter only one class each day.
2. All classes will have a minimum of three heats, maximum of six (depending on entries in each class and overall each day). Best single run determines qualifying standings. Maximum 10 cars per race, minimum 3.
3. In EP, there will be three A Finals and one each lower final. In GP, there will be one A Final and lower finals.
4. Race times will be: EP-5 minutes; GP-Heats 5 minutes, 10 minutes for lower finals and 20 minutes for the A Final.
5. EP-A Finals: final placings will be determined by best two out of three results (points award 1 to 10 depending on finishing position each final) with result of third final used as a tie break. If still a tie, qualifying will be used.

General

6. Transponders will be used. Entrant's responsibility to securely attach transponder. If transponder falls off, laps will not be counted. Personal transponders catered for.
7. Cars will be scrutineered.
8. Drivers will be required to marshall the race immediately following their race, except in finals—organisers will advise marshalling duties for finals.
9. If you cannot marshall, you must supply a reasonable excuse and provide a substitute marshall. Race organisers to be advised prior to the start of the race concerned. Arranging a substitute marshall so you can work on your car is not considered a reasonable excuse.
10. Failure to marshall will mean loss of best result in heat and/or final.
11. Trophies will be awarded to all A Finalists and Top Qualifier in each class.

Code of Conduct

At all times participants are expected to conform to decent actions, both on and off the track. Violation of such expectations may lead to the organisers requesting the offending participant/s leave the complex.

Car Specifications and Technical Details

AARCMCC rules will apply unless outlined below.

EP Touring Cars Stock

Any commercially available 24° Rebuildable 27 turn Stock motor that meets ROAR rules. It does not have to be on any "Approved list". No hybrids. 6 x 3800mAh cells maximum. Tires—Open.

EP Touring Cars Modified

IFMAR approved Modified motors. Hybrid motors (assembled from IFMAR approved motor parts) allowed. Brushless motors not allowed. 6 x 3800mAh cells maximum. Tires—Open.

GP Touring Cars Pull Start

Kit/RTR pull start engines (.12, .15/.16) only allowed. They must be air cooled with two stroke induction. Only glow plug ignition is allowed. No modifications or hybrid engines allowed.

Engines must be started with the pull start—no other starting aids allowed.

Note: It is not necessary for your car to race with the engine it came with, you can use another engine provided that engine is sold in commercially available kits/RTRs (in Australia). You cannot use an aftermarket engine in this class.

The purpose of this rule is to prevent high powered aftermarket engines running in this class (eg Nova, JP, RB etc). No carbon fibre options allowed.

GP Touring Cars Open

Any .12 size engine allowed, pull start optional. Turbo plugs allowed.

For all GP Cars

Two or three speed transmissions allowed. Tires—open. Tuned pipes permitted both classes. Nitro—maximum 30%

Both EP and GP

Bodies—2 or 4 door Touring Car/Sedan bodies only. No Sports/GT/GTP types. Spektrum radio systems allowed.

Maximum Entries

Maximum entries per day will be 150.
