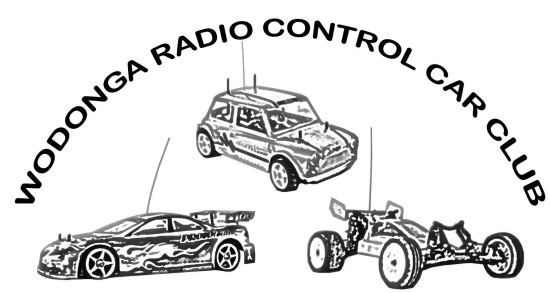

* 540 Pro will be running handout motors, which will be part of the entry price.

* 540 Pro will run Take Off 27's supplied by the competitors these tyres will be marked prior to the race qualifying and entrants will only be allowed 2 sets marked and used during the meeting (Can be purchased with entry if preferred)

* Stock, 19 Turn and Modified will be running control tyre/rim/insert combination, this year the chosen wheel is Take Off Pre Mount 27's, which are a Take Off 27 tyre with a medium insert on a Take Off rim, each set (4) will cost \$42.00 with your entry and each driver is allowed 2 sets for qualifying and a 3rd set can be purchased by drivers who make the A mains.

Rules and Additional Information

RULES:

540 Pro

Any brand of IFMAR legal ISTC chassis. 540 Silver can Johnson/Mabuchi standard replacement metal endbell (hand out motor). Motors may not be modified or tampered with in any way. Unrestricted gearing. Take off 27's.

19 Turn (demo)

Any brand of IFMAR legal ISTC chassis. 19 turn brushed motors or 5800 brushless motors. Open to any manufacturers. Open body.

Stock

Any brand of IFMAR legal ISTC chassis. IFMAR approved 4-door sedan body shell. Commercially available 27 turn brushed single wind Rebuildable Stock motor, ROAR approved motors only (no modifications allowed to the motor). Hand out Take Off 27 wheel/tyre combo.

Touring Car Modified

Any brand of IFMAR legal ISTC chassis. Brushed or brushless sensored motors are allowed. No limit. Open to any manufacturers. Any IFMAR approved 4-door sedan body shell. Hand out Take Off 27 wheel /tyre combo.

Tamiya Mini

Tamiya M01/2 or M03 series 'Front wheel drive' chassis only assembled as per instruction Manual and no chassis modifications allowed. 540 Johnson/Mabuchi or Tamiya Sport Tuned only. ESC, bearings and Tamiya Hot ups permitted. Small size Mini wheels only with any commercially available rubber mini-sized tyres.. Mini or Tamiya Suzuki Swift body shells only.

Batteries

Batteries are limited to 4300 and fit with in IFMAR battery specs. No LiPo batteries.

Marshalling

Drivers will be required to marshal the race immediately following their race. After each heat the participants in that heat will place their cars and transmitter into impound and assume assigned marshalling positions for the following heat. If you cannot marshal, you must supply a reasonable excuse and provide a substitute marshal. Race organisers must be advised prior to the start of the race concerned. Failure to marshal will mean loss of best result in heat and/ or final.

Race Format

Friday 4th May - Track open from 9:00am until 5:00pm

Saturday 5th May - 4 Qualifiers, regrade after round 2 and round 4.

Sunday 6th May - 2 Qualifiers, 3 Finals for A mains, 1 for each of the lower mains.

Tyres

The word tyre in this context refers to tyre, insert and rim combination.

Drivers will only be able to access one complete set of tyres at a time, the other set(s) if they have chosen to have them will be kept in scrutineering. Drivers must return the tyres they have in order to access another set, tyres can be swapped 1 for 1 or 2 for 2 etc.

It is the drivers responsibility to ensure that none of the scrutineering marks are removed or damaged, failure to do so will result in disqualification.

No modifications are allowed to tyre/rim or insert. Drivers are allowed to run a bead of glue around the edge where the tyre joins the rim.

It is the drivers responsibility to make sure the tyres are glued prior to each race.

All tyres must be handed back after Saturday Qualifying, failure to do so will result in the driver being disqualified.

Failure to use the control set(s) of tyres will result in instant disqualification from the event.

540 hand out motor

Each driver in 540 will receive a handout motor to use for the event, the motor must be used in all races, failure to use the correct motor will result in instant disqualification.

It is the drivers responsibility to ensure that none of the scrutineering marks are removed or damaged from the motor, failure to do so will result in disqualification.

It is the drivers responsibility to ensure proper gearing of the motor, If you damage the motor you not get a replacement.

All motors must be handed back after the last round of qualifying on Saturday, failure to do so will result in the driver being disqualified.

Motors will be checked during the race meeting, any drivers who have been found to have tampered with the motors will be disqualified.
