Track maybe run wet or dry depending on the condition of the dirt, so be ready for both conditions. If the track packs down before the race date and we decide to run dry, we'll post it with this info. Won't know until track rebuild is completed.

Hello Racers!!

There have been many concerns on how the main events are going to be ran on Sunday 08/03/14. To ease your concerns and make this race even better, we decided to run AAA-mains for all classes Sunday!!

Just as a reminder you must have more than five (5) drivers present to race in order to run the class!!

** if you enter Run-What-You-Brung class you may not enter any other classes. This keeps the class for novice and beginners only.

The top eight (8) drivers through qualifying from Saturday will ensure you a secure spot for the AAA-mains.

To make it interesting, there will be no bump-ups for lower mains.

Larger classes that end up having lower mains will have a chance to get into the AAA-mains based off "The Gauntlet"!!

"The Gauntlet"- Lower mains will be ran first to determine the two (2) fastest drivers out of all the lower mains for that class division. They will be placed into the 9th and 10th spot in the AAA-mains based off their laps/time in that class division!!

Drivers are not allowed to stand on any device on the drivers stand that brings there waist level above the railing height. Should a shorter driver need to be elevated to see over the railing a step stool may be used however at no time should there waist be above the railing. Drivers may not use milk crates,5 gallon buckets or the like. Race Director has the final say as safety comes first. Failure to abide by this will result in a 1 lap penalty or DQ.
