Friday Evening 1/10 Scale 500 Lap Team Enduro

Teams of 2 or 3 drivers will compete to be the first to complete 500 laps and take home the trophy.

- Teams may consist of 2 or 3 drivers only. No single drivers, no teams of 4
- Teams may be pre-made but single competitors will be paired randomly at the event
- Teams will be responsible for marshalling their own car throughout the event
- All registered team drivers must share equally (approximately) in the driving

Entry Fee: \$30.00 per team. A 50/50 draw will award half of the proceeds to one random team.

Specifications (Subject to change)

Motor	21.5 Brushless (Silver Can permitted with suitable gear ratio)
Controller	Any ESC but timing must be disabled ('blinky' mode)
Gear Ratio	4.0 or higher
Battery	Max 5600mAh, Limit 4 packs per team (unlimited recharges)
Body	Any 190mm or 200mm Super Touring GT2 Body – i.e. Porsche, Corvette, BMW,
	Jaguar, Nissan, etc. (Please no race bodies – Mazda Speed 6, LTC-R, R9, etc)
Tires	Any Touring Rubber Tire (5 Spoke or Dish Rims). Limit 2 sets per team.
Notes:	Light kits must be installed and functioning with at least 2 lights.

Friday Night 1/8 Scale 90 Minute Lap Shootout

Drivers will compete in 3 separate 30 minute heats to complete as many total laps as possible in 90 minutes. The driver (or team) with the most laps after 90 minutes will take home the trophy.

- Single drivers or teams of 2 may compete
- Teams must divide the driving equally (approximately)
- Heats will alternate every 30 minutes

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per team. A 50/50 draw will award half of the proceeds to one random team.

Saturday - Open Practice

The track will be open for practice Saturday from 9am to 4pm for practice.

- All Scales, All Classes
- 9am to 1pm will be open practice. We will regulate classes from time to time to improve the experience for all drivers
- 1pm to 4pm will be used to conduct heats and races for popular classes.
- AMB Transponders are required to take advantage of Lap Timing. Results will be made available throughout the day for those wishing to monitor their lap times. A limited number of transponders may be available for a \$5.00 rental fee. First come, first served.

Fee for full practice will be \$10.00.

Saturday Night - GT2 and GT1 Shootout

Drivers will be competing in a series of qualifying rounds to take the pole in the Main Event. All participants will receive an accumulating score based on their performance in the Main Event. At the close of season, the driver with the most points will earn the Shootout Trophy

- GT2 and GT1 classes only. Please see www.drcrc.ca/classes.php for details.
- Races will alternate between GT1 and GT2 with 20 minutes between rounds.
- AMB Transponders are required to take advantage of Lap Timing. Results will be made available throughout the day for those wishing to monitor their lap times. A limited number of transponders may be available for a \$5.00 rental fee. First come, first served.

Entry Fee: \$10.00 for one class. \$15.00 for both.

Sunday - Trophy Race

Drivers will compete in one or more classes over a series of qualifiers to take the pole position in the Main Event races. The winner of Main Event races will take home the trophy for the respective class. (Note: minimum of 6 drivers required per class to award a trophy)

- Classes: GT1, GT2, Pan Car, F1, Mini, Nitro, 1/8 GT2, *NEW: On-Road Core Truck

- In the event that less than 6 drivers register for any given class, classes may be combined when possible (i.e. Pan Car and F1)
- AMB Transponders are required to compete. Limited numbers may be available for a \$5.00 rental fee. Inquire at the timing table. (Security Required ie. Car Keys)

Race entry fee: \$20.00 for 1st class, \$10.00 for 2nd class, \$5.00 for 3rd class. No charge for additional classes. (*Note:* We have reduced the cost to drivers running a single class)

We will be trying to quicken the pace as we are now running additional classes and heats and want to give everyone their money's worth. We will make every effort to arrange heats so that drivers running multiple classes will have time to prepare in between races and marshalling.

We will be trying to minimize the time in between heats of the same round. The announcer will begin calling the next heat to Pit Lane during the last minute of the current race. Please prepare and head to Pit Lane as soon as possible.

We will run at least 2 heats and a main for all classes. Time permitting, we will try and run 3 qualifiers.
