- Direct Drive 19T/10.5 (GTP body, max 6 cell for 10<sup>th</sup> & 4-cell for 12<sup>th</sup>, no Li-po)
- 10<sup>th</sup> Nitro Sedan (1725 grams, 4 door body, ROAR .12 engines)
- Off Road W/O Jumps (10<sup>th</sup> scale stadium trucks and buggies only)
- Monster truck w/Jumps (any size truck, no 1/8 buggies)
- 48 Minute Endurance (Lemans type body, no Li-po, must change driver)
- 1/18 Mini W/O Jumps (Bring it, run it)

## Power Availability

Racers will need to supply their own power for this race.

## Format

- Each class will run 3 qualifying heats followed by a main event. A-main qualifiers in Sedan 19Turn, Sedan Stock and Super Touring will run in a conventional Triple A-main format with the best 2 out of 3 races used to determine a winner. The remaining classes will run single A-mains. The Nitro class will run a 30 minute A-main, 20 minute B-main and a 10 minute C-main. All other mains will be 5 minutes long.
- Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers of all mains after the last race is completed.
- Trophies will also be awarded to the concourse winners and the top qualifier in each class.
- Concourse winners do not have to run their winning body but the car must be drivable.
- All cars will be inspected at the conclusion of each race and will not be returned until the following race has finished. If a car is not in tech by the start of the following race, results from that race will be thrown out. The Race Director will handle all rule infringements.
