## Format

- Each class will run 3 qualifying heats followed by a main event. A-main qualifiers in Sedan 19 Turn, Sedan Stock and Super Touring will run in a conventional Triple A-main format with the best 2 out of 3 races used to determine a winner. The remaining classes will run single A-mains. The Nitro class will run a 30 minute A-main, 20 minute B-main and a 10 minute C-main. All other mains will be 5 minutes long.
- Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers of all mains after the last race is completed.
- Trophies will also be awarded to the concourse winners and the top qualifier in each class.
- Concourse winners do not have to run their winning body but the car must be drivable.
- All cars will be inspected at the conclusion of each race and will not be returned until the following race has finished. If a car is not in tech by the start of the following race, results from that race will be thrown out. The Race Director will handle all rule infringements.
