

# **SSGP Rules and Regulation for Bodyshell and Wheel**

One of the objective of SSGP is to stimulate the realism of full scale car racing. Hence, realistic bodyshell and wheel are compulsory requirement.

Realistic bodyshell refers to 1/10 bodyshell that replicates the full scale On-Road, Road Legal, or Racing Car modified from Road Legal vehicle, such as Super GT cars.

Realistic wheels refers to replica multispoke wheel, instead of dish wheel.

Below is the list of allowed and disallowed bodyshell for SSGP.
