NoviceRTR Brushed, 27T, or 17.5 Brushless – No Boost

No Monster truck, 1/8, or 4 WD allowed

Novice SC......Core Trucks & Buggies Only! Same Motor Rules as Novice

Stock Truck......17.5 Brushless or 27T Brushed Motor. Boost Ok.

Stock Buggy......17.5 Brushless or 27T Brushed Motor. Boost Ok.

Stock SC......17.5 Brushless or 27T Brushed, RTR Brushed Motor. Boost Ok.

Mod Truck, Buggy, 4WD, SC, SCB....All Mod Classes are Open Motor

Mod SC 4x4, Elec 1/8...Open Motor, No Battery Restrictions

Battery Rule: 7 Cell NiCad/NiMh or 2 Cell Lipo Max, (1/8 & SC 4X4 Excluded)

4 or more entries required to make a class

Each class will be 2 heats and 1 main

You must run 1 heat to qualify for the mains and the points.

GENERAL RULES:

All transponders must be returned immediately after each race before you corner. House transponders are available at the track. If transponders are taken from the track there will be a \$25.00 fee. If transponders are lost, there will be a \$125.00 fee.

The following WILL NOT BE TOLERATED:

Unsportsmanlike conduct

Rough driving

Intentional bumping

Suspension and/or expulsion may result and all points/tickets will be forfeited. This is at the discretion of the race directors and/or Mike and Penny.

TRIP TO HAWAII: includes 2 round trip tickets, 5 nights, 6 days & parking.

Here is how you win:

1 ticket will be picked by random draw at the awards ceremony race. You will be given your ticket(s) at the awards ceremony. You must be present to win.

How to get tickets:

You must race 7 of the 9 races to get 1 ticket. If you race all 9 races, you will get 1 additional ticket. You may run more then 1 class, but the same rules apply. If a class starts the series, but then does not have enough racers to continue, this will <u>NOT</u> qualify for the Hawaii tickets. Some restrictions will apply.
