

TAMIYA R/C 16th ASIA CUP SINGAPORE CHAMPIONSHIP 2013 <u>GENERAL INFORMATION</u>

1) Race Schedules :

20 January 10 March 14 April 19 May 09 June 14 July 11 August

(dates subject to changes) (venue will be released when registrations open)

- 2) Overall race results will be based on best five (5) out of seven (7) races , whereby the final race in Aug 2013 will be the 5th result.
- 3) Overall Champion for each class qualifies automatically for the 16th Tamiya Asia Cup Finals to be held in September 2013 in Bangkok, Thailand*.
 (Flight Ticket** will be sponsored)
 (Parts support up to \$300)
- 4) The 1st 3rd runner-ups also earn the rights to qualifies for the 16th Tamiya Asia Cup Finals to be held in September 2013 in Bangkok, Thailand*. (Accommodation & Flight own expenses) (Parts Support up to \$200)

*Drivers attending the TAC Finals will have to bear all the charges for motors and batteries usage which they can keep after that.

Important Note : From 2011, Overall champion can only get ticket to TAC Finals twice (regardless of category) whereby the 3rd time, ticket will be allocated to the next best winner. (All previous winners are considered once)





TAC 2013 consists of 6 categories (5 main categories + 1 support category) which are :-

- SUPERSTOCK TOURING (Only Open to drivers who did not get into A main of TAC Finals)
- 4WD GT
- M CHASSIS
- F104
 - (Ex-TAC Finals Champions)
- FF03
- RM-01 (support category not entitled to TAC Finals)
- 5) Registration Fee S\$30 per category S\$50 per two categories Additional S\$10 per category for three categories & above.
- 6) Registration : a) TAMIYA/STARGEK SHOWROOM
- Registration closes one (1) day before race day. Late registration will not be entertained. Only confirmed entry with payment will be registered in AMB system.
- The following TAC Point System will be in use in this championship. Please refer to Table 1. Furthermore, driver(s) who clock the fastest qualifying single lap time will be awarded an additional 2 points.
- 9) In a case of racers draw on points after 3 rounds of finals (with 1 throw away) the throw away results will be used to determine the final standings. In a case that the throw away position are the same, the lap and time of the throw away result will be use to determine the standings.
- 10) Protest against any final results for either qualifying and finals must be made immediately after the run and before the start of the next run while the result confirmations and inspections are going on.
- 11) Only Official Race Inspector/s are allowed to hand check all cars to ensure fairness.

- 12) Race director and Race organizer will have the final say on all protest made.
- 13) Only Official Appointed race director and staffs of race organizer are allowed to do race control work to ensure fairness is made.
- 14) Awards will be given out to the Top 3 drivers of each class every race.
- 15) Incentives will be given to the overall Top 8 drivers of each class at the end of the championship who completed 5 races at the minimum inclusive of the final race in Aug 2013.
- 16) Race results will be posted at Stargek and www.mylaps.com. Related Information about the TAC Races will be posted on rctech.net and Tamiya-Stargek FaceBook page.
