General Rules:

Failure to obey racing rules will result in a verbal warning.

Further violation of rules will result in disqualification and the racer will be asked to leave the track. Zero Tolerance.

On track violations will result in removal of laps. Number of laps deducted will be determined by severity of violation.

- Reverse is prohibited at any time during racing. It is allowed only during practice.
- No radios should be on in the pits while cars are racing on the track. This applies to all frequencies. Please make use of the frequency clip board at the timing table when practicing.
- After your race has finished, set your equipment down in your pit, and choose a marshalling position. Vehicles must be turned off before leaving the track surface. There will be no driving of vehicles back to your pit area.
- Marshalling is required after your race. If you cannot marshal, please find a substitute or inform the timing table. Marshalling for a different race is acceptable.
- Running of vehicles back and forth or "drag racing" between parking lot aisles is strictly prohibited. Running of vehicles in the east parking lot is prohibited. Running of any vehicle must be performed on the designated track surface. Carry vehicles to and from the track surface, please do not drive through the parking lot .
- Vehicles should be placed on the track and refueled in the designated pit lane for the safety of your vehicle and other vehicles that are already running on the track.
- Nitro vehicles may be run, tuned, or warmed up as long as all wheels are off the ground. Throttle must be controlled by physically moving the servo by hand.
- All electric heats and mains will be 6 minutes long. Nitro heats will be 5 minutes long. Nitro A-main will be 10 minutes long, lower mains will be 5 minutes long. Time between heats will be 3 minutes. Please make sure vehicles are ready or warmed up when it is time to race.
- Racers are encouraged to inform the timing table if they witness any violation of class or general rules.
- Please follow proper racing etiquette and sportsmanship while racing. Rough driving will be penalized.
- 4 entries are required in order to form a separate class
- No alcohol or drugs are allowed on premises at any time.
